

CITY OF BRISTOL

(VARIOUS ROADS, STOKE LANE AREA, WESTBURY-ON-TRYM WARD, CITY OF BRISTOL) (PROHIBITION OF WAITING) ORDER 201-

The City Council of Bristol hereby gives NOTICE that it proposes to make a traffic order, the main effect of which would be:-

1. to introduce new waiting arrangements for vehicles in **Back Stoke Lane, Briarwood, Charlecombe Road, Coombe Lane, Cooper Road, Downs Cote Avenue, Downs Cote Drive, Downs Road, Great Brockeridge, Little Withey Mead, Parry's Close, Parry's Lane, Reedley Road, Stoke Grove, Stoke Lane, Westbury Road, Withey Close East and Withey Close West**; and
2. to revise existing waiting arrangements for vehicles in **Abbey Road, Falcondale Road and Lampeter Road**.

Opportunity is also taken to rectify existing traffic sign anomalies.
