CONSTRUCTION OF ROAD HUMPS BIBURY CRESCENT AND WELLINGTON HILL WEST, HORFIELD AND WESTBURY-ON-TRYM & HENLEAZE WARDS, CITY OF BRISTOL

NOTICE is hereby given that the City Council of Bristol in exercise of the powers conferred by section 90A of the Highways Act 1980 as amended, (hereinafter called 'the Act') and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the chief officer of police in accordance with section 90C(1) of the Act and those bodies or persons prescribed by the Highways (Road Humps) Regulations 1999 as amended (hereinafter called 'the Regulations') and in accordance with section 90C(2) of the Act, intends to construct road hump at the location specified in the Schedule to this Notice.

The road hump will be in the form of a speed table, which will extend over the full width of the carriageway and will be 75 millimetres in maximum height, subject to the tolerances permitted in the Regulations.

SCHEDULE Location of Road Hump

BIBURY CRESCENT AND WELLINGTON HILL WEST

At the junction of Bibury Crescent and Wellington Hill West, along their respective lengths as follows:-

- (a) **Bibury Crescent** - from Wellington Hill West south westwards for 10 metres
- (b) **Wellington Hill West** - from 23 metres north west of Bibury Crescent south eastwards for 38 metres
